



1. Eligibility: Anyone ages 6 and up may enter in the Saturday Night Cosplay event. Entrants ages 6-13 must have their parents permission to enroll, and **MUST** be accompanied by a legal guardian or relative of age. Children below the age of six **CANNOT** enter cosplay on their own, but can be considered a “prop” in group or duo performance. For those who feel that the addition of a cute baby as a prop is wholly unfair, it’s never too late to make your own for next year.
2. Costume Guidelines: Frankly, no costume is **NO COSTUME**. And although there are many popular Anime/fiction characters that wear what many would consider “normal clothes,” for a simple guideline turn on Pokemon: “Brock” is wearing normal clothes, however “James” is not. “Normal Clothes” characters can participate in group appearances if the rest of the cast is in costume or there is elaborate prop use involved.
3. Cast Limit: Eight(8) person maximum for group appearances.
4. Content: **COSPLAY IS AN ALL AGES EVENT**. This means the harshest language allowed on stage is G-Rated. The same goes for subject matter. The Cosplay should be considered a PG rated event.
5. Props: What goes on the stage with you, comes off the stage with you. For safety reasons things like confetti, fireworks, flash paper or other forms of pyrotechnics, rose petals, water, and other small messy objects are strictly forbidden from the stage area. On stage, (non firing) toy weapons will be allowed without peacebonding but be aware that any “live” weapons will result in an immediate eviction. Also, no food, animals or remote control devices.
6. Due to time - There will be no skits.
7. Registration: We will have registration before the contest, but due to time limits and number of people who like to participate in the event we suggest you pre-register.
8. Reference material is not required but strongly recommended.
9. You are required to wear a nude body suit under your costume if your costume would be rated above a PG rating. If you are not sure, bring one anyway and consult the Cosplay coordinators, or email cosplay@tokyointulsa.com.
10. The judges decisions are **FINAL**.
11. Referance Material is required.
12. Each entrant or group will be judged on Workmanship, Accuracy, Creativity and Enthusiasim.
